
An array of exhibitor space is available for new and existing exhibitors and vendors across shopping and food pavilions and outdoor sites.



Space types

Shell Scheme Indoor Sites

Take the stress out of organising your stand build and let us do it for you! Based on the pavilion you select, we organise the site build including walling, flooring, fascia signage, lighting and power based on your requirements.

Ground Space only – Indoor Site

We provide you with your designated space and you have the creative freedom to build it as you like. You must organise your own stand build & flooring and arrange power & lighting requirements direct with us. **Complex stand builds must be approved by RASWA before build commences.**





Marquee Outdoor Sites

Due to the duration of the Perth Royal Show, you must have a certified marquee structure outside, no marquees with pop up legs. With this site option, we organise the marquee based on your requirements(size/ lighting & walling requirements) and make sure its installed before bump in.

Ground Space only - Outdoor Space

Much like the indoor option, we provide you with your designated space and you do the rest. You must organise the stand build (if needed) and supply RASWA will your power and plumbing requirements. *Again, complex stand builds must be approved by RASWA before build commences.*

We launched our business at the Caravan and Camping show at Claremont Showgrounds in March 2019. It was there where we were approached at our stall by RASWA about attending the Perth Royal show - this was something we never really considered for our type of product being High end Retro and Off-Road Campers. But OMG it worked a treat and we have been back every year since. You just cannot beat the local Western Australian exposure. Application Process

The steps below outline each stage of the application process so you know what to expect. This year there is a Royal Show Exhibitor e-Portal which will be a hub of information and keep you in the loop with important updates.

APPLY TO

START

To start the process of reaching up to 350,000 potential customers visit **perthroyalshow.com.au** or contact the **Exhibitor Services** on **08 6263 3147** and complete the expression of interest form.

2 SUCCESSFUL APPLICATIONS

Once the Perth Royal Show has reviewed your expression of interest to exhibit and deemed it successful, you will receive a link to the Perth Royal Show Exhibitor e-Portal which contains all the important information you require, including site options and pricing.

B SECURE YOUR STAND

Once a site and pricing has been agreeable, successful applicants are required to pay a 30% non-refundable deposit within five days to hold their site.

AGREEMENT AND FORMS

After the deposit has been received you will be required to complete and sign the exhibitor agreement forms and upload to the Perth Royal Show Exhibitor e-Portal. Forms include the site application form, public and product liability insurance, workers compensation, food forms, risk assessment and covid vaccination certificates.

5 EXTRA SERVICES AND MARKETING

After you have uploaded your agreement you will be offered an opportunity to purchase additional items such as electricity, plumbing solutions and staff passes. You will also get the opportunity to opt-in to marketing and promotional opportunities.

6 SECURE YOUR STAND

Once final payment has been made you can access your official 2023 Perth Royal Show Exhibitor Pack on the exhibitor e-portal, with everything you need to get prepared for the Show, including staff passes, bump in/out passes and lots more.

Essential Information

SITE FEE

Each of the commercial pavilions have a different fee structure. Please contact our Exhibitor Services to secure a commercial site tailored to your specific needs.

INSURANCES

It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to arrange Public, Product and Workers Compensation Insurance to cover their liabilities in respect to all aspects of their activities at Claremont Showground. The exhibitor will affect and maintain the following insurances:

- a. Public and Product Liability Insurance to insure the interests of the Royal Agricultural Society of WA (RASWA), the exhibitor and its contractors and subcontractors for an amount of not less than:
 - i) Exhibitors operating rides, activities and games \$10 million (\$10,000,000) and the policy must include a cross-liability clause.
 - ii) Caterers and showbag retailers \$10 million (\$10,000,000).
 - iii) All other exhibitors \$5 million (\$5,000,000).
- b. Professional Indemnity Insurance exhibitors providing treatment including, but not limited to, massage, acupuncture, blood and other tests, will provide evidence of professional indemnity insurance with an indemnity limit of not less than \$5 million (\$5,000,000).
- c. **Employers Indemnity Insurance** in the name of the exhibitor insuring liability under workers compensation legislation and at common law in respect to employees, contractors and subcontractors and including the interest of RASWA as Principal.
 - i) In the event no employees or subcontractors are engaged, the declaration must be completed and signed by the exhibitor.

STAFF AND OPERATING HOURS

All exhibition stands are to be staffed with engaging staff throughout the hours of operation of the pavilion or area.

SITE LICENCE AGREEMENT

In order to operate as an exhibitor at the Perth Royal Show, all exhibitors are required to sign and return their Site Licence Agreement or complete the online application together with their completed Product Listing before the start of Show.

FOOD & BEVERAGE SAMPLING, TASTING AND SELLING

All exhibitors considering sampling and/or selling food and/or beverage must complete and return a Food Notification Form and pay the applicable fees.

SECURITY

RASWA provides routine security for its buildings and ground. RASWA will not accept any responsibility for the protection of exhibits nor for any loss or damage how so ever caused. The exhibitor must accept responsibility for claims under the Workers' Compensation Act or any other Act or Regulation related to their activities during the Show.

PARKING

No parking is provided by the Perth Royal Show and limited parking is available nearby. The Perth Royal Show encourages the use of public transport.

The Perth Royal Show is Western Australia's biggest event and receives a high level of media coverage and exposure, generating great public awareness and engagement. The Royal Show Marketing and Media Team operates from the Showground and is onsite throughout the Royal Show to manage all media visits and opportunities.
