The Wood Chopping carnival at the Perth Royal Show is the biggest and most prestigious in WA attracting Axemen from all over Australia and New Zealand. The modern Perth Royal Show competition was launched in 1929 and grew from a two-day event to the major drawcard it is now. Wood chopping in WA dates back to 1892 when the first competition was staged in Albany. It has its origin as a sport in the days when the timber industry was thriving and much of our infrastructure, including railway sleepers, was made by hand using axes. Those working in the industry had competition amongst themselves which became popular with onlookers, and soon wood chopping became a spectacular sport.


SOME HELPFUL TIPS FOR COMPETITORS



WOODCHOPPING

Section Conditions

To be conducted under the rules of the Australian Axemen's Association at the Claremont Showground, Claremont, from Saturday 23 September to Saturday 30 September 2023.

1. COMPETITORS' PASSES

1.1 Passes to the Showground for the days and/or nights when Wood Chopping events will be conducted will be emailed to competitors after entries have been received. The pass to the Showground must be scanned at the gate. Admission to the Wood Chopping Arena is free

2. MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL

- 2.1 Jarrah logs will be used in all events. Logs to be cut under the Rules of the Australian Axemen's Association and the administration of the Western Australian Axemen's League.
- 2.2 Competitors are advised that they are not to dig footholds in the Wood Chopping Arena.
- 2.3 Only Competitors and Officials are allowed in the ring at the time of competing. Non-compliance of this rule will mean a fine will be issued.
- 2.4 During presentations all activities of all persons must cease in the Wood Chopping Arena.
- 2.5 Any Competitor conducting him/herself in an unruly manner, conspiring with others to cause discontent, to deceive the officials or breaching any of these Section Conditions may be disqualified or dealt with as the Society may deem fit.
- 2.6 No juniors are allowed to train without parent or coach supervision.

3. MEDICATION CONTROL

3.1 Under the provision of the Axemen's Council of WA Rules, axemen may be tested for the presence of prohibited substances.

4. DRESS

4.1 WA Competitors must wear a club singlet, white trousers, and white boots or shoes. All visiting axemen must compete in State or Club dress. Sponsors' singlets must be worn in their events and on the presentation dais only.

5. JUDGING

- 5.1 The video takes preference over the Judges. No person or axemen is permitted to view the video prior to lodging protest.
- 5.2 Please note all championship events will be drafted into heats on the day of the event.

6. SLABBING RULE

6.1 Is as the 2016 Australian Axemen's Association Rule Book. This complies with Work Safe.

7. CHAMPIONSHIP RULE

7.1 Competitors in championship events must also have entered at least two (2) handicap events of that type.

8. JUNIOR EXHIBITORS

8.1 Junior exhibitors are required to have their Parent(s) or Legal Guardian(s) present at all times while in the Wood Chopping Arena.

9. CATALOGUES

- 9.1 Catalogues listing all exhibits entered in each class may be purchased at a cost of \$10.00 and should be ordered and paid for at the time of entry.
- 9.2 Only a limited number of catalogues will be available for sale during the Show.

10. ADJUDICATING COMMITTEE

- 10.1 The purpose of the Adjudicating Committee is to resolve all matters pertaining to the competition throughout the Show.
- 10.2 The Committee will consist of the following:

- Chief Ring Steward
- · Assistant Ring Steward
- Western Australian Axemen's League Representative

11. REFUNDS

11.1 If COVID-19 recommendations and mandates advised by the Federal and State Governments mean the competition class you entered cannot proceed in 2023, the RASWA will issue a full refund of your entry fee.

GENERAL SHOW

Regulations

The Society's General Show Regulations and Section Conditions regulate the conduct of the Show. Upon acceptance of an entry the Exhibitor is irrevocably contracted to be bound by those General Show Regulations and Section Conditions.

A copy of the Society's General Show Regulations may be obtained on application or downloaded from the website http://perthroyalshow.com.au/general-regulations/.

An Exhibitor who breaches any General Show Regulation or Section Condition may be disqualified, or suspended for any period, fined or otherwise penalised.

WITHDRAWAL OF EXHIBIT BY THE SOCIETY

The Society may, at its sole discretion, withdraw, reject or disqualify an exhibit. Refer to the Society's General Show Regulation 3.18.

PRIZE MONEY

RASWA has a policy whereby all prize money is paid by EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer). Your banking details will be kept secure and can only be used by RASWA to credit your bank account. Please complete your account details on the application for entry even if you have provided them previously. In accordance with the rules of the competition, failure to provide your bank details will mean that any prize money you earn will be forfeited and retained by RASWA.

Prize money as stated in the schedule does not include GST. The prize money which the Society pays to successful Exhibitors ("you") depends on the information that you provide to the Society.

If you confirm that you are GST registered and provide your Australian Business Number (ABN) the Society will pay the appropriate prize money plus 10% GST. The Society will provide to you a Recipient Created Tax Invoice (RCTI) within 28 days of the day you were successful at your event, detailing the GST which you will need to submit to the Australian Tax Office (ATO).

If any adjustments need to be made, the Society will issue an adjustment note to you within 28 days of the adjustment. Upon entry into the competition and completion and signing of the application form, this form will become a RCTI agreement as required under (Goods and Services Tax) Act 1999.

Furthermore, you acknowledge your agreement to the following:

- The Society will issue you a tax invoice in respect of the successful exhibit;
- You are requested not to issue a tax invoice to the Society in respect to prize money received;
- It will be necessary for you to notify the Society if you cease to be registered for GST; and
- The Society will notify you if it ceases to satisfy any of the requirements of the determinations.

If you provide your ABN but are not registered for GST, the Society will pay the prize money as detailed in the prize schedule.

If you are a business Exhibitor and do not provide your ABN to the Society, 47% tax will be deducted from your prize money under the ATO PAYG provisions.

If you confirm that you are entering as part of a private recreational pursuit or hobby, the Society will pay the prize money as detailed in the prize schedule.

INSURANCE

As the Society accepts no liability for loss or damage occasioned to or by any property exhibited, it is recommended that the Exhibitor arranges appropriate "all risks" insurance for their exhibit(s).

AWARDS

The Society will not be responsible for awards or prize money not received by Exhibitors after 31 December 2023. If you have not received your award(s) or prize money by 30 November 2023 please contact RASWA on (08) 6263 3100.

SOCIETY'S LIABILITY

The attention of Exhibitors is drawn to General Show Regulation 17, with reference to the Society's Liability.


