PERTH ROYAL SHOW COMMUNITY STAGE

You're invited to perform on the Community Stage at the 2023 Perth Royal Show! Showcasing a variety of WA homegrown top talent, we extend an invitation to all established and up and coming superstars to get involved! Don't miss out, submit your applications for consideration by Monday, July 10th 2023.

We are searching for a variety of local talent to entertain our diverse range of guests and showcase their talents over the eight days of the Royal Show. Acts can include soloist, duos, and group performances from any performance area with past performers including dance acts, cheerleading groups, musicians, choirs, magicians, circus troupes, storytellers, poets, comedians and so much more. The Community Stage operates between 10:00am and 6:00pm daily over the eight days.

Performing on the Community Stage provides an amazing opportunity for local artists to engage with the general public and demonstrate their talent. Performers have the opportunity to distribute flyers and place approved signage and banners prior to, during and after their performance set. All acts are engaged on a voluntary basis with a chance to win one of the two cash prizes, winners will be selected at the end of the eight days.



ENGAGEMENT DETAILS

- Participation is on a voluntary basis only
- Each act will be asked to perform at least once during the eight days; however, you
 may be asked to perform on multiple occasions depending on availability.
- Performance timeslots will range between 15- and 20-minute sets.
- The Community Stage is partially covered, concrete slab stage measuring 12 metres wide by 6 metres deep.
- A small change and storage area will be available backstage; however, as these
 areas will be shared between all artists, we encourage performers to arrive onsite
 in costume and with as little to store as possible.
- A sound system with a technical operator will be onsite each day to playback any audio files needed and provide any audio support required.
- Please ensure you provide as much detail as possible in your application form as all programming will rely on accurate technical requirements.
- All applications under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian, to and from the stage area.
- A drop off point at a designated gate into the showground will be allocated closer to the show; however, onsite parking is sadly unavailable.
- All participants take full responsibility for their own safety and the safety of their belongings. RASWA takes no responsibility for any damages to props, equipment, and personal items whilst onsite.

Successful applicants will be notified by Friday 28th July 2023

All successful applications will receive one general admission ticket to the Perth Royal Show on the day of their performance PLUS one additional general admission ticket for a parent or guardian to attend, if applicable
